

2011 MICHIGAN ELECTRICAL CODE RULES Part 8
INCORPORATING THE 2011 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE
Ordinance Number 08-13-2013-03

An ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of Keeler Township under the provisions of The Stille-DeRossett Hale Single State Construction Code Act, 1972 PA 230.

The Bureau of Construction Codes has amended the Construction Code Rules, Part 8. All units of government that administer and enforce the electrical code shall enforce the amended state electrical code effective July 1, 2013.

The rules adopt by reference the National Electrical Code, 2011 edition, and include deletions, additions, and amendments to the national code. The deletions, additions, and amendments are set forth in this publication.

The National Electrical Code, 2011 edition, is adopted by reference in R 408.30801 (page 1). The provisions set forth in this publication are either added to the national code or amend the national code.

Part 8. ELECTRICAL CODE

TITLE. Rule 87. Title, These rules shall be known as the Michigan Electrical Code, hereinafter referred to as "the code". R 408.30807.

90.4 Enforcement. The code is intended to be suitable for mandatory application by governmental bodies that exercise legal jurisdiction over electrical installations, including signaling and communications systems. The enforcing agency shall interpret the rules, decide on the approval of equipment and materials, and grant special permission set forth in the rules. By special permission, the enforcing agency may permit alternative methods where equivalent objectives may be achieved by establishing and maintaining effective safety.

REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PUBLICATION. The ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same.

This ordinance duly adopted on October 1, 2013 at a regular meeting of the Keeler Township Board and will become effective the day following the date of publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same.
