

ORDINANCE NO. 2003-01

KEELER TOWNSHIP FIREWORKS ORDINANCE

Please take notice that after a Public Hearing held on January 7, 2003, Keeler Township ordains that the Keeler Township Zoning Ordinances are amended by adding the following Ordinance:

1. Upon application in writing on forms provided by the fire marshal, the Township may grant a fireworks permit on forms provided by the fire marshal, use of the fireworks is limited to the purposes set forth in the permit. The permit is not transferable and shall not be issued to a person under the age of 18 years.
2. Applicant must furnish proof of adequate financial responsibility by bond or insurance for potential damages or personal injuries.
3. A permit shall not be issued to non-residents of Keeler unless a resident agent upon whom process may be served is provided.
4. The township board shall rule on the competency and qualifications of operators and on the time, place and safety aspects of the display before granting permits.
5. Sections of this ordinance are deemed severable.
6. Violations of this ordinance shall constitute a 93-day misdemeanor with a \$500.00 fine. Each day of violation is a separate offense.
7. Ordinance will take effect upon publication.
